Mrs. Rose Dies; Rites Wednesday

Mrs. Zora G. Rose, 84, passed away Sunday afternoon at the Lone Elm Rest Home, following failing health the past few years.

The daughter of John and Zada Rose Wilder, Mrs. Rose was born June 24, 1884, at Cassopolis, Mich.
