Mr. Rozendaal rites Monday

Walter M. Rozendaal, 80, of Sully died Thursday, Nov. 24, at Grinnell General Hospital.

Funeral services were conducted Monday at the First Reformed Church at Sully, with the Rev. Daniel Hakken and the Rev. Ralph Menning officiating. Burial was at the Sully Cemetery, with the Garden Chapel Funeral Home in charge of arrangements.

The son of William and Jane Terlouw Rozendaal, he was born Sept. 19, 1903, at Lynnville. He was married to Margaret Barta on Dec. 28, 1928. Mrs. Rozendaal died in 1950.

On June 1, 1953, Mr. Rozendaal was married to Hendrika Zegers Van Weelden at Sully.

Mr. Rozendaal was a farmer and had lived all his life in the Lynnville-Sully area. He was a member of the First Reformed Church of Sully and served on the consistory.
