The funeral of Evelyn Tindall Chamness Rugland, 80, of Montezuma was Jan. 25 at Watts Funeral Home. She died of a heart attack at McAllen Medical Center in McAllen, Tex., on Jan. 21. The Rev. John Darlington officiated and burial was in Jackson Township Cemetery. *Ref 27*
