**Ex H-R Pressman,
Mr. Rutherford Dies
In Grinnell Home**

Arthur W. Rutherford, 78, a longtime resident of Grinnell who lived in the Lone Elm Nursing Home for the last three years, died Saturday morning, Dec. 23, at the Home.

The son of Adam and Sadie Delay Rutherford, Mr. Rutherford was born in Grant Township, Poweshiek County, Iowa, on April 20, 1889. Though a deaf mute, he became a proficient pressman and was associated with the former Grinnell Herald when it was headed by the late W. G. Ray and Lowrey Frisbie.

Mr. Rutherford never married and leaves no survivors. He was preceded in death by his parents.

Funeral services for Mr. Rutherford were held at 1 p.m. today (Tuesday) at the Smith Funeral Home with the Rev. Chester E. Custer of the Grinnell Methodist church officiating.

Organist was Mrs. Willard Heffner and pallbearers were LeRoy Johnson, Bill Davenport, D. M. Reynolds, Don Sparks, Columbus VanTrees and Fred Weber.

Burial was in Hazelwood cemetery.
