Max Ryan, 61, Brooklyn, died Monday, April 6, 1992, in the VA Medical Center, Iowa City.

Memorial Services were held at 11 a.m. Fri., April 10 in Nevenhoven Funeral Home, with Rev. Kalen K. Fristad, Pastor of the Grace United Methodist Church, officiating.
