Joe F. Safken Dies in Victor

Joe F. Safken, 67, of Victor died suddenly Thursday, Mar. 6. Death was attributed to a heart attack.

The son of Fred and Eva Safken, he was born on a farm near Malcom Oct. 24, 1901. At the age of seven, he moved with his family to Victor where he lived the remainder of his life. He graduated from the Victor public school in 1921.

On Feb. 28, 1937, he was united in marriage with Alice Doran of Brooklyn. The couple had one daughter. Mr. Safken worked as a mechanic in the Ford garage there for several years, and in 1930 he built the garage and service station which he operated until his death.
