Garnet Grey Davis, daughter of James and Rebecca Ellen Gilbert Davis, was born in Fremont, Iowa, January 26, 1884. At the age of 6, she came with her family to Grinnell where she had resided since with the exception of 4 years in Illinois.

On April 20, 1904, she was united in marriage with Lewis J. Sampson of Grinnell. Five children were born to this home. Two died in infancy.

Nine years ago she suffered a stroke and gradually failed in health. She received the loving care of her husband and children in her home until Saturday, April 26, 1958, when she entered the hospital and passed away three days later on April 29, 1958, at the age of 74 years.

She loved her home and was a devoted wife and mother and always thought of helping her family and friends. She was a member of the Methodist church and Rebekah lodge.

She is survived by her companion of 54 years; and by three children, Lynn Sampson of Milwaukee, Wis., and twins Mrs. H. Robert (Geraldine) Peak of Oelwein, Iowa, and Gerald Sampson of Grinnell. Others surviving include four granddaughters and three grandsons, one sister, Mrs. Ruth Steele of Montezuma, Iowa, and one brother, William Davis of Phoenix, Ariz.; nieces, nephews, and many friends.

Funeral services were held on Thursday, May 1, 1958, from the Smith Funeral Home with Dr. G. S. Bruland, pastor of the Methodist church, officiating.
