

Miss Caroline Elmira Sanders died at the home of her brother, No. 403 Fourth avenue, on Tuesday last at 9:30 in the morning, at the age of 78 years, the cause of death being an acute attack of Bright's disease. She was born in New Ipswich, N. H., and came here in the early days of Grinnell, with her parents. Three brothers survive her, D. A. Sanders and Howard Sanders, both living here, and G. L. Sanders, who is spending the winter in California. The funeral is announced for tomorrow afternoon at 2 o'clock, Rev. J. A. Hurley of the Baptist church officiating.
