Charles H. Sanders was born in Green county, Ohio, July 24, 1877, and departed this life at Kansas City, December 20, 1919, at the age of 42 years, 7 months and 26 days. He leaves to mourn his loss his father of Grinnell, Iowa, one daughter, Hilda. Des Moines, Iowa, one brother, Fank, one sister, Mrs. W. Martz, of Grinnell, hesides a host of friends who have all proven their worth during these days when friends are so badly needed. One daughter died in infancy 16 years ago.

Mr. Sanders came from Ohio at the age of 3 months with his parents and has resided the most of his life in Poweshiek county, Iowa.
