Mrs. Sanders dies in Oregon, 1980

Mary Morrison Sanders, 57, a former Grinnell resident, died Aug. 1 at a Medford, Ore., hospital. She had been suffering from lymphoma since Christmas, but had been hospitalized only a few days prior to her death.

Memorial services were held at Grants Pass, Ore., with Bishop Kim Jordan officiating. The PEO Sisterhood participated in the memorial. Burial was at Hillcrest Memorial Park in Grants Pass.

The family suggests memorial contributions to the Oregon Lung Association or the Oregon Cancer Society, in care of the Lundberg Funeral Home, Grants Pass.

The daughter of Frederic and Fay C. Morrison, she was born in Grinnell. Her father was formerly vice president of the Morrison-Ricker (later Morrison-Shults) glove factory. She attended schools here and was graduated from Grinnell

College in 1935. While in college, she held several swimming records. She taught school in Gilman for two years prior to her marriage in 1937 to Bert V. Sanders, now of 404 Currie Lane, Grants Pass.

Mr. and Mrs. Sanders had lived in Southern California, Oregon, Nevada and, again, in Arcadia, Calif., before moving to Grants Pass in 1965. Mrs. Sanders was a member of the Second Ward of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints in Grants Pass, Chapter DC of the PEO Sisterhood, and the Al-Anon family group.

She is survived by her husband, Bert; three daughters, Fay Smith of Temple City, Calif., Lucinda Williams of Auburn, Wash., and Jane Galante of Kealahou, Hawaii; 11 grandchildren; and two brothers, James R. Morrison of Kensington, Calif. and Paul W. Morrison of Minot, S.D.
