

# Ardyth "Kay" Sather, 85

Ardyth K. "Kay" Sather, 85, a resident of the Montezuma Nursing and Rehab Center, and formerly of Des Moines, died Friday, Jan. 18, 2002, at the care center.

Graveside services were Tuesday, Jan. 22, at the Glendale Cemetery in Des Moines with the Rev. George Salmave officiating. Watts Funeral Home, Montezuma, was in charge of arrangements.
