Jesse H. Scott, 76, of Corwith, Ia., died Tuesday morning at Grinnell General Hospital. He had not been in good health and had recently moved to Grinnell to be near his daughter, Mrs. Madge Johnson of rural Grinnell.

Services for Jesse Scott were held at 1:30 p.m. today (Thursday) at the Corwith United Methodist Church. Burial was in the Corwith Cemetery.

Born in Paxton, Ill., on Oct. 27, 1902, he was the son of Thomas John and Loretta McCoy Scott. His family moved to Corwith while he was still young, and he graduated from Corwith High School in 1921.

He married Pearl Bunting on Dec. 27, 1922. The couple had three daughters, Delores, Shirley, and Madge. He farmed for many years near Corwith.

He was a member of the Corwith United Methodist Church and was a Past Master of the Corwith Masonic Lodge and Past Worthy Matron of the Order of the Eastern Star.
