Mrs. Molly Scott was born at Maryville, Mo., March 29th, 1849, and passed to her home beyond Saturday morning, Oct. 13, 1928. She had been a patient at the Community hospital for some time, suffering from a broken hip which was caused by a fall and caused her death.
