Walter Alvin Scott.

Mr. Scott died at his home in Grinnell, Thursday, November 13, after an illness of several months. He was taken to the sanitarium at Colfax but all that medical skill could do proved unavailing.

Mr. Scott was born in Des Plaines, Ill., March 27, 1856. He was married to Miss Georgia A. Perham of Geneseo, Ill., Dec. 19, 1877, and they moved to Grinnell in March, 1891. Mr. Scott leaves a wife and two children: W. Vaughn Scott, of Los Angeles, Cal., and Mrs. Hazel Black, of Grinnell.

The funeral was held from the home of his brother on Summer St., on Friday at 3 o'clock, and was largely attended. The floral offerings which came from all parts of the county attested to the high esteem in which he was held by his many friends.

The services were in charge of Rev. J. M. Brown, pastor of the Methodist Episcopal church. The Knights of Pythias attended in a body and had charge of the services at the grave.
