

SCOTT.—At his residence in Warren township, Friday, Jan. 1st, 1929, W. P. Scott, aged 75 years. He was one of the old settlers of Powelton county and enjoyed the friendship of a wide circle, who now mourn his death and sympathize with the family. Mr. Scott was born in Ireland, in 1854, and came with his parents to America when he was but four years old. They settled in Somerset county, Penn. He there attended public school. From there he moved to Ohio and lived upon a farm until 1870 when he came to this county and settled in Warren township. In 1888 Mr. Scott was married in Holmes county, Ohio, to Miss Eliza Manatt. For 37 years they have made this their home and in his death the country loses one of its pioneer settlers. The funeral services were conducted at the residence Sabbath afternoon, by Rev. J. W. Wright, assisted by a quartet choir from Victor. The remains were interred in the Brooklyn cemetery.—*Chronicle*. i-1-1929.
