

Hold Scull rites today

Robert G. Scull of Isabel, Tex., died on Saturday, April 2, in a boating accident at South Padre Island, Tex. Authorities said that he drowned.

Funeral services for Robert Scull will be held at 7 p.m. today (Thursday) at the Friends Church in Lynnville. Organist for the service will be Harriet Macy, and vocalist will be Mrs. Doyle Schultz. Burial will be in Woodland Cemetery in Lynnville.
