**Morton Seeley, 76,  
Former Resident  
Here, Is Dead**

Morton Seeley, longtime resident of Grinnell, died August 15 at Rockwell City, Ia., friends here have learned.

A jeweler, Mr. Seeley took his apprentice training at the age of 16 in Grinnell, and had been a jeweler in Stuart, Council Bluffs and other Iowa towns before going to Rockwell City in 1931.

Born at Greeley, Ia., he came to Grinnell as a youth and was married here to Addie Gates on Jan. 16, 1906. He was a member of the Methodist church here, sang in the choir and taught Sunday school.

Surviving are his wife, Addie; two sons, Howard of New York City and Paul of Boone. Burial was at Manchester, Ia.

He was associated with E. A. Marsh in the jeweler and watch-making trades here.
