Myron Leo Seeman, 82, of Montezuma, Iowa died Thursday, Nov. 16, 2000 at the Montezuma Nursing & Rehabilitation Center in Montezuma.

Funeral mass was Nov. 20, 2000 at Granger Assumption Catholic Church in Granger, IA with Father Eugene Koch officiating.
