## Jefferson Shaw, Lynnville Resident, Dies Wednesday

LYNNVILLE (Special): Jefferson Shaw, son of James and Clara Burton Shaw was born at Taintor on August 12, 1879, and departed this life on October 6, 1965, in Mahaska hospital in Oskaloosa where he was taken a few hours prior to his death. He had been a patient in Tower Park home for the past several months.

Mr. Shaw farmed in the Taintor-Lynnville area before moving to Lynnville upon retirement.
