

## Ray C. Shedenhelm 12-19-79

Funeral services were held Monday, December 17, at 1:30 p.m. at the McAninch-Fremming Funeral Home in Victor, for Ray C. Shedenhelm, 80, of rural Brooklyn.

Rev. David Hornok, pastor of the Victor Baptist Church, officiated at the services.

Mrs. Don Alba, organist, accompanied her husband who sang.

Mr. and Mrs. Glenn Urfer and Mr. and Mrs. Fred Waline were in charge of flowers.

Concluding services and burial were held at the Guernsey Cemetery with Russell Fetzer, Harland Muller, Melvin Smith, Ted Bohstedt, Dale Risdon and Arthur Blome serving as casket bearers.

Ray Clarence Shedenhelm was born February 2, 1899 at his parents home southwest of Ladora, Iowa. He was one of four children born to the marriage of William Thomas and Cora Belle Graff Shedenhelm.

He attended rural school in the Ladora vicinity where he grew to manhood.

On March 7, 1934 Ray was united in marriage to Cecelia Heinen at the Methodist Parson-

age in Ladora. They lived in Ladora before establishing farming residences in the Ladora, Victor and, most recently, Brooklyn communities. Ray was a member of the Ladora Methodist Church and later transferred his membership to the Victor Baptist Church in Victor, Iowa. Due to failing health, Mr. Shedenhelm became a resident of Brookhaven Nursing Home in Brooklyn. He died Saturday, December 15, 1979 at Memorial Hospital, Marengo.

He was preceded in death by his parents and two sisters - Mrs. Merle Rinehart and Mrs. Ruth Carlson.

Ray is survived by his wife - Cecelia, and a brother - Harry Shedenhelm of Ladora.
