Requiem Mass On Tuesday For Elizabeth Sheehy

Mrs. Elizabeth Ann Sheehy, 79, wife of Jerry Sheehy of Searsboro, died suddenly Saturday morning at a Des Moines hospital. She had fallen a week earlier and suffered a broken hip.
