Rites April 17 For Mrs. Sheley

Funeral services were held Thursday, April 17, at Long's Funeral Home in Anita for Mrs. Mary Sheley, 98, who died Monday, April 14, at the Crestwood nursing home. Mrs. Sheley was the last of a family of ten children and would have 99 years old June 14.
