Word was received on Friday of the death in Marinette, Wisconsin, of Mrs. Eva Garner Sherman, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Pearl Garner, of this city, and services in her memory were held Sunday at Ida Grove, the former home of the family.

Mrs. Sherman was born June 5, 1888 in Ida Grove and after finishing school at Sac City Institute, entered Grinnell College, graduating as a popular member of the class of 1912.
