Mr. Shipley services held

Warren H. Shipley, 59, died Sunday morning at his home in Toledo. May 21, 1978

Funeral services for Mr. Shipley were held at 1:30 p.m. Tuesday at the Mason-Hand Funeral Home in Tama, with the Rev. Clyde King, pastor of the First United Methodist Church, officiating. Burial was at Oak Hill Cemetery in Tama, with the Reining-Friedrich Post No. 72 of the American Legion conducting military honors.

The son of Orville and Vena Bobzin Shipley, he was born Sept. 10, 1918, in Jasper County. He received his education in Tama County.

On Dec. 23, 1942, he enlisted in the U.S. Army. He was discharged in 1946 after having served in the Philippines, New Guinea and Luzon.

He was married to Ida

Pauline Church Barker of Tama on April 19, 1954, at Lancaster, Mo. The couple lived on farms in Marshall and Tama counties until Mr. Shipley became a custodial employee of the South Tama Junior High School in 1967. He was forced to retire in February of this year because of ill health.

Survivors include his wife; three step-children, Charles C. Barker of Marshalltown, Jerry L. Barker of Toledo, and Russell G. Barker of Tama; 11 grandchildren; two great-grandchildren; a sister, Esther M. Shipley of Grinnell; and two brothers, Kenneth L. Shipley of Sully and Leonard Shipley of Odessa, Tex.

He was preceded in death by his parents and a brother, Wilmer.
