Elbert M. Smith, professor emeritus of French and music at Grinnell College, died of Alzheimer's disease Saturday morning, Dec. 20, at the Mayflower Home Health

Center.

The son of Melvin L. and Anna Laura Morse Smith, he was born on <u>Dec. 12, 1901.</u> in Waupun, Wis. He attended public schools in Elderon, Wis., and Waupun High School. He was a Phi Beta Kappa graduate of Lawrence College. receiving his B.A. in 1924 and his M.A. in 1926. Both degrees were in Romance languages. In 1927 he received a bachelor of music degree in organ and theory from the Lawrence Conservatory. He purused graduate work in French at the University of Wisconsin and the Universite Laval in Quebec. Prof. Smith studied organ

both in the U.S. and Europe. He taught at Knox College in Galesburg, Ill., and the University of Wisconsin before joining the Grinnell faculty in 1935 as college organist and instructor in modern foreign languages. He became professor of French and music in 1967 and retired with emeritus status in 1970

Prof. Smith also served as the college's carilloneur and as organist at the United Church of Christ-Congregational, retiring from the latter post in 1981. He was the designer of the church's pipe organ.

He was an active member of the lowa Chapter of the

the church, officiating. Burial will be in Hazelwood Cemetery, with the Smith Funeral Home in charge of arrangements.
