Isaac Elmer Schooley, son of William Webster and Margaret A. Schooley, was born near Searsboro, on April 14, 1872. He went with his parents to Lynnvile in early boyhood where he remained until he grew to young manhood. Later he went to Pocahontas county, Iowa, where he was united in marriage with Miss Lula Hanke on December 16, 1900. They came to Grinnell in September, 1908, where they have since resided.
