Last Rites Said For Ervin Schultz

Ervin L. Schultz, 61, of Rte. 1, Malcom, passed away Thursday evening at Grinnell General Hospital West, following an extended illness.

Pickhardt Schultz, Mr. Schultz was born on Nov. 16, 1907 in Malcom township. He attended the rural schools of that community and was a graduate of Malcom high school.

On Nov. 27, 1929 he married Elizabeth Pfund in Des Moines and following their marriage the couple farmed on a farm six miles east of Grinnell where Mr. Schultz has lived his entire life.

Mr. Schultz was a baptised and confirmed life long member of Trinity Lutheran Church, and served as treasurer of Trinity Lutheran Sunday School for 20 years. He was also a member of its brotherhood.
