Mrs. Frank S. Schultz Dies at Her

Home in Malcom Friday Forenoon

After Long Illness.

The death of Mrs. Frank S. Schultz took place at her home in Malcom Friday morning at 9 o'clock. She had been an invalid from a rhoumatic affliction for thirteen years, and her malady gradually got worse until the end.

Florence Henshaw was born in Oskaloosa, Iowa, May 15, 1880. Early in life she came to Poweshiek county, settling in Sheridan township. Before her marriage to Frank S. Schultz, which occurred fourteen years ago this fall, she was a teacher in the schools of the county.

She leaves to mourn her loss her husband and one daughter, Esther, aged thirteen years.

Mrs. Schultz was a woman of fine character. Though most of her mature years were clouded by a severe affliction from which she suffered greatly, she bore it with cheerfulness and courage.

The funeral was held from the Malcom Presbyterian church, Sunday at 2:00 p. m.
