Mrs. Chris Schultz.

Frances Elizabeth Broders was born on the 18th day of January, 1869. In early infancy she was baptized in the Lutheran church near Malcom, where later, at the age of 13 she was also confirmed. On the 15th of November, 1888, she was united in marriage to Mr. Chris Schultz. This happy union was blessed with three children, one child who died in infancy, Lila and Ethel.

Mrs. Schultz had been ill for many months, and her long illness caused her much suffering. About five weeks before her death Mrs. Schultz was taken to the Methodist hospital in Des Moines, where she was operated upon. The operation proved a success, and Mrs. Schultz seemed to be getting along as well as could be expected, when another operation proved necessary, which was performed on Wednesday morning. This strain proved more than she could bear, and on Fri-

day morning, the 4th of June, she passed away at the age of 46 years, 4 months and 16 days.

She leaves to mourn their loss her husband, two daughters, her aged mother, three sisters, two brothers and a host of friends. Mrs. Schultz was a sincere Christian; she bore her suffering with Christian patience that had its source in a life of faithful prayer.

The funeral was held Sunday afternoon, Rev. Salzmann officiated. The body was laid to rest in the Grinnell cemetery.
