

Harold Schultz services held

Harold A. Schultz, 67, of 1432 West St., Grinnell, died of a stroke Wednesday evening July 23, at his home.

Funeral services were conducted at 1 p.m. Saturday at the Smith Funeral Home, with the Rev. Harry H. Linnenbrink, pastor of St. Mary's Catholic Church, officiating. Organist was Kathleen Heffner. Pallbearers were Harold Edgington, Carl Fenner, Kenneth Halstead, John Higdon, Ross Mintle and Robert Osborn.

Burial was in Hazelwood Cemetery. Memorials in Mr. Schultz's name may be left at the funeral home.

The son of George Arthur and Dora Elizabeth Speck Schultz, he was born on the family farm in Sheridan Township on April 23, 1919. He attended rural school and

graduated from Grinnell High School in 1938.

During the World War II, Mr. Schultz served as a Seabee with the U. S. Navy in the South Pacific. He was married to Mardene Fae Provin on May 1, 1942, in Des Moines. They farmed in Sheridan Township until moving to Grinnell in 1985.

Mr. Schultz is survived by his wife, his mother and one sister, Margaret E. Duncan of Sun City, Ariz. He was preceded in death by his father.
