Mary E. Snell of the Iowa College class of 1869, died at her home in Berkeley, California, May 14, 1908. Her life since her graduation has been spent in California and has been that of an earnest, devoted and successful teacher. Snell Seminary, which she founded in Oakland and afterwards removed to Berkeley, may stand as representing her contribution to the development in young girls of a cultured, refined and gracious womanhood, so fully exemplified in her own person and character. 5-19-08
