

Former Resident Of Poweshiek Dies

Wesley Snook, of Iowa City, for many years a resident of Poweshiek county, died at his home Wednesday, June 27, at the age of 86 years. He had been ill for several months.

Mr. Snook was a native of Iowa and was born in Lone Tree on June 12, 1842. He came with his parents to Poweshiek county when a small child, and for more than 60 years was a resident of Warren township. About 16 years ago he moved to Iowa City where he had since made his home. His wife died several years ago. He is survived by a sister, Mrs. Bodyfield of Ericson, Nebr., who is 94 years old, and numerous nieces and nephews.

Mr. Snook passed through the pioneering in this community, and aided in transforming the prairie wilderness into its present highly-cultivated state. He was a man of the highest integrity and the older settlers here, who remember him as a neighbor and friend, speak of him in terms of highest praise.

The body was brought to Victor Friday morning for interment at the I. O. O. F. cemetery in the family lot beside his wife. A brief service at the grave was conducted by Rev. E. L. Early of Ladora.—Victor Record.
