Anna C. Spading Rites Wednesday

Anna C. Spading, 83, passed away Sunday evening at the Newton hospital, where she had been a patient for the past few weeks.

The daughter of Theodore and Joanna Schultz Buchenau, she was born on June 28, 1882, in Poweshiek County. She attended the rural schools of this county until the age of 12½ when her mother passed away and she left the schools to take care of the family.

She was united in marriage with Robert O. Spading on August 29, 1900, at Grinnell. Following their marriage they farmed in the Grinnell and Malcom communities until March of 1929 when they moved to Malcom, where they lived until the death of her husband on June 20, 1958, when she moved to Grinnell. For the past few years she has lived in Newton.

She was a member of the Lutheran church.

Survivors are her children — Theodore of What Cheer, Iowa; Mrs. Mabel McKeag of Burlington, Iowa; Mrs. Clara Smith of Colfax, and Mrs. Ella Graham of Malcom; also 21 grandchildren, 52 great grandchildren, her sister, Mrs. Lena Broders of Brooklyn, Iowa, and her nieces and nephews.

She was preceded in death by her parents, her husband, two children in infancy, and three brothers — Theodore Buchenau, Henry Buchenau, and Louis Buchenau.

Funeral services for Mrs. Spading will be Wednesday afternoon at 2 o'clock at the Presbyterian church in Malcom. Interment will be in the Trinity Lutheran cemetery.
