Mrs. Spaulding Services Friday

Gertrude B. Spaulding, 93, a former resident of Grinnell, passed away Wednesday morning at Wichita, Kan.

Mrs. Spaulding was born on Oct. 16, 1876, at Sibley, Iowa, and was united in marriage to Frederick E. Spaulding, who preceded her in death in 1942. She lived in Grinnell for 36 years and moved to Kansas City in 1936 and since July of 1968 she has lived in Wichita, Kan.

Mr. Spaulding was the son of the founder of Spaulding Manufacturing Co., a major Grinnell Industry in the early 1900s, and was a partner in the company.

Survivors include two daughters — Mrs. Robert A. Brooks of Lee-wood, Kan., and Mrs. John E. Monroe of Wichita, Kan., and four grandchildren.

Mrs. Spaulding was a member of the Westminster Congregational Church of Kansas City and the P.E.O.

Graveside services for Mrs. Spaulding will be Friday at 2 p.m. at the family lot in Hazelwood Cemetery. The Rev. Newell E. Davis, pastor of the United Church of Christ—Congregational, will officiate.
