

## T. L. Spillman <sup>G-4</sup> <sup>8-26-1932</sup> Funeral Today

The funeral of Terry Lee Spillman, age 57, was held this afternoon at 2 o'clock at the Lower Blue Point church with the Rev. A. B. Cadwell of Grinnell in charge. Mr. Spillman was a former resident of Blue Point, but lived at the time of his death in Fargo, N. D.

Mr. Spillman died Monday at 3:50 p. m., as the result of an auto accident one mile west of Bird Island, Minn. He was taken to a hospital in Willmar, Minn., but died three hours after the accident. The accident occurred when a car came onto the highway on which Mr. Spillman was traveling, and stopped about half way across the pavement. The driver of the car in which Mr. Spillman was riding started to go around, and all of a sudden the other car started again, and ran into the right rear wheel of the Spillman car. Mr. Spillman was thrown from the automobile onto the pavement and his skull was fractured. The car in which he had been riding then turned over several times, never leaving the pavement.

Mr. Spillman had gone into Minnesota by bus, and he met a family from Fargo with whom he was acquainted, and they asked him to ride home with them. He accepted the invitation, and was riding in the front seat of the car when the accident occurred. The other occupants of the car were not seriously injured.
