Funeral Services On Saturday For Floyd O. Stanley

Floyd O. Stanley, 67. Rte. 4, Grinnell died early Wednesday morning at his home following failing health of the last several years.

Funeral services will be held at 2 p.m. Saturday from the Smith Funeral Home with the Rev. Miss Myrtle Lee, pastor of the Searsboro Friends church, officiating. Organ music will be by Mrs. Kathleen Heffner.

He was the son of John and Etta Myers Stanley and was born Aug. 21st, 1893, near New Sharon. He attended the local rural schools, graduated from Grinnell high school and later attended Grinnell College.

On Aug. 7th, 1917, at Denver, he was united in marriage with Fave James. To this union three children were born: Craig Stanley of near Montezuma, 'Kenneth Stanley of Manistee, Mich., and a daughter who died in infancy.

In addition to his wife and two sons, Mr. Stanley is survived by five grandchildren and one brother, Harold of Rte. 4, Grinnell.
