Friends Pastor Over 46

Rev. Glenwood L. Stanley, 74, died of a heart attack yesterday morning at his home.

Funeral services will be held Saturday, November 12th, at 2:00 p.m. at the Lynnville Friends Church. The Rev. Charles O. Whitely of Grinnell and the Rev. Carl D. Byrd of Lynnville will officiate.

Burial will be in Friends Cemetery at Lynnville.

Pastor 46 Years

A pastor of the Iowa Yearly Meeting of Friends for over over 46 years until his retirement five years ago, Rev. Stanley had served at Sugar Creek, Searsboro, Indianola and Salem. He was a resident of the Lynnville-Searsboro vicinity all of his life except while serving at his other pastorates.

He is survived by his widow, Mrs. Bertha Williams Stanley, and the couple had celebrated their golden wedding anniversary only last June 28th.
