Funeral services for James H. Stauss, provost and executive vice president of Colorado College and former dean of Grinnell College, were held at 11 a.m. Monday in Colorado Springs. 12-27-75

Dr. Stauss, 61, died Saturday in Colorado.

A memorial service will be held here in late January, and Grinnell College officials said a memorial fund will be established in his name.

Born April 4, 1914, in Otterville, Iowa, he was appointed to the post of associate professor of economics at Grinnell College in 1946. Promoted to a professorship four years later. he also served as chairman of the faculty for the year 1955-56.

Dr. Stauss was named dean of the college in 1960, and one year later was also appointed Jesse Macy professor of social studies. He served as acting president of Grinnell in the between interim the resignation of Howard Bowen and the appointment of Glenn Leggett as president of the college. From 1966 to 1969, he held the title of provost of the

A 1936 graduate of Grinnell College, he received his M.S. degree from Iowa State University in 1937 and his Ph. D. degree from the University of Wisconsin in 1945. He became provost and executive vice president of Colorado College in 1969.

Survivors include his wife Harriet and three children.
