

Steele dies in Sun City *April 2, 1979*

Stanley Steele, 71, of Sun City, Ariz., died Thursday, March 29, of an apparent heart attack at Boswell Hospital. A former resident of Grinnell, he ran Steele Motor Parts here for several years.

Memorial services, following visitation at the Menke Funeral Home from 2 to 5 p.m. Sunday, will be at 11 a.m. Monday at the United Church of Sun City. Burial will be in Sunland Memorial Park.

A World War II vet and a member of the United Church of Sun City, he was also a past president of the Sun City Youngtown Kiwanis. He and his wife left Grinnell in 1973 after he had managed the local NAPA franchise for some years.

He is survived by his wife, Ethel, and two sisters, Lila McKinney and Lenora Croft, both of California.
