Flora Addell Taylor Stillwell,
daughter of W. A. and M. W. Taylor,
was born near Searsboro, Sept. 28,
1883 and departed this life at her home
east of Searsboro on February 22,
1922. The direct cause of her death
was pneumonia, although she had been
an invalid for eleven years, unable to
walk, but was always cheerful and
uncomplaining.

She became a member of the M. E.
church at Blue Point at an early age,
and lived as a sincere Christian the
rest of her life.

She was united in marriage with
Elias Stillwell August 2, 1900. To this
union were born four sons: Glen, the
eldest, Roscoe, Floyd and Fred, the
baby, being 12 years old at the time
of his mother's death.

She also leaves an aged father, five
brothers, three sisters and a host of
relatives and friends to mourn her
death.

Funeral services were held at the
West Liberty church on Friday af-
ternoon at 2:00 o'clock, conducted
by Rev. Mr. Warren, of Des Moines,
