Edwin W. Stone Is 8-22 Buried at Haven

Edwin W. Stone, the son of Mr. and Mrs. T. L. Stone was born December 16, 1855 in Clearfield Co., Pa. and died August 17, 1924 at Belle Plaine, Iowa, being at the time of his death 68 years, 8 months and 1 day old. Stone of Grinnell, Iowa, and one adopted brother, Fred T. Stone, along with their respective families and a number of other friends.

The services were held at the Haven church conducted by Rev. C. F. Martin, Frederika, Iowa. Burial was in the Haven Cemetery.
