Alfred Strand Dies Wednesday In Local Hospital

Alfred Strand, age 89, retired farmer of the Chester community, died early Wednesday morning (Sept. 6) at St. Francis Hospital following a brief illness. The son of Gabriel and Torbor Thompson Strand, Mr. Strand was born near Dunbar, Iowa on Jan. 25, 1878. He attended the Dunbar and Newburg schools and began farming early in life in the Newburg and Chester communitties.

On Dec. 8, 1906, he was married to Kathrine Engelson at Marshalltown, Iowa. He was preceded in death by his wife, Kathrine, on March 16, 1963; his parents; and 10 brothers and sisters: George, Theodore, Cornelius, Edwin, and Emil Strand; Mrs. Ida McClure, Misses Nettie and Hannah Strand and twins in infancy.

Survivors include his seven children: 15 grandchildren and 12 great grandchildren; as well as one brother and one sister: Jesse Strand of Gilman and Mrs. Dena Eames of Grinnell.
