

An Obituary Of Edwin Strand

Edwin Strand, son of Mr. and Mrs. Gabriel Strand, was born in Marshall county near Dunbar, July 11, 1881. He departed this life April 15, 1934, aged 52 years, nine months and four days. From early childhood he has taken the Quaker faith as his guide to heaven.
