Louise A. Strand, 98, formerly of Newburg died of renal failure Thursday, Jan. 26, at St. Francis Manor.

Graveside services were conducted at 10:30 a.m. Monday at Prairie View Cemetery, Gilman, with the Revs. Keith Briggs and Kenneth Wallace officiating. The Smith Funeral Home was in charge of arrangements.

The daughter of Wallace and Alice Martin Green, she was born March 13, 1890, near Gilman. She attended rural school.

She was married to Edwin W. Strand Oct. 24, 1907, in Gilman, and the couple

farmed near Newburg. She sold the farm following her husband's death in 1934 and worked as a practical nurse in central Iowa. She later worked at Ritter Hardware and Spurgeon's Store.

Mrs. Strand was a member of the Newburg United Church of Christ. She organized 4-H clubs in Chester and Hickory Grove townships and in 1931 was named Master Homemaker of Poweshiek County.

She is survived by four grandsons, 14 great-grandchildren and seven great-great-grandchildren. She was preceded in death by her husband; a daughter, Bernice Stoaks; one grandchild; one brother and three sisters.
