

Glen Strong⁶⁻²⁰ Services Held¹⁹⁷²

Glen William Strong, 76, of Stockton, Calif., died Tuesday, June 20, in Stockton, following a lengthy illness. ¹⁹⁷²

The son of John M. and Amilia Meesz Strong, he was born Oct. 4, 1895, in Malcom Township. He made his home in the Malcom and Montezuma area until 1935, when he moved to California and worked as a landscape gardener.

Mr. Strong is survived by his three sisters, Vada Whitehead of Montour, Mrs. Clarence (Aleta) Simpson of Mon-

tezuma, and Mrs. Lester (Rena) Hamilton of Ewart, along with several nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his parents and one sister, Mrs. Della Strong Roberts, who died in 1965.
