Landon Hull, 90, of Searsboro died Thursday, June 4, at Iowa Methodist Medical Center in Des Moines.

Funeral services for Landon Hull were held at 10:30 a.m. today (Monday) at the Searsboro Community Church, with the Rev. Don Job officiating.
