Doris L. Taylor, 79, of Milan, Ill., died May 3 at the Moline, Ill., Lutheran Hospital. Services were held May 7 at Trinity United Methodist Church in Milan and burial was in Salem Township Cemetery, Yates City, Ill.

The daughter of Henry Harold and Edith A. Sheppy McCulloch, she was born Feb. 16, 1905, in Hickory Grove Township, Jasper County. She graduated from Grinnell High School and taught in rural schools.
