CAPT. NORMAN TAYLOR

Services for Capt. Norman E. Taylor, 29, of Del Rio, Texas, were held April 4 at Rose-Neaph Basier Chapel in Basier City, La. Fr. Richard K. Pusch, chaplain at Barksdale Air Force Base, officiated. Burial with full military honors was at Hillcrest, Basier City.

Taylor, an Air Force captain, was killed Mar. 30 in a single engine aircraft near Lake Amistad in Del Rio.

He was born in Des Moines, Iowa. He was a 1974 graduate of Parkway High School in Basier City, and a 1980 graduate of Louisiana Tech University. He had been an air force pilot since 1981.

Capt. Taylor was an instructor pilot stationed at Laughlin AFB in Texas, and was scheduled to be this year's operation 'Joy' chairman.

He is survived by his wife, Carmen Taylor of Shreveport, and a daughter, Christine. Also his maternal grandfather, Rex Rose of Deep River, his paternal grandmother, Mrs. Letha Taylor of Des Moines, a sister, Deborah Taylor of Shreveport, and a brother, Mark Taylor, of Basier City.
