Frank Thackeray went to Boone and accompanied the body to Grinnell and the funeral was held at 2:30 o'clock this afternoon from the Methodist church, conducted by Rev. J. M. Brown, assisted by the Eastern Star lodge. Interment was in Hazelwood cemetery.
