

## Charyl W. Thompson

Charyl Wayne "Tommy"  
Thompson, 76, of Petaluma,  
Calif., formerly of Grinnell,  
died Friday, Oct. 29, in  
Petaluma.

A memorial service will be  
conducted Wednesday, Nov. 3  
at the Petaluma Methodist  
Church, Petaluma, Calif.

He was born Sept. 17,  
1917, in the Blue Point area.  
He was a Grinnell High  
School graduate.

On June 17, 1938, he was  
married to Maxine Rempp.  
The couple lived in Grinnell,  
and Mr. Thompson worked as  
a fieldman for DeKalb. They  
moved to San Diego in 1942,  
and he worked as a flight  
engineer for Consolidated Air-  
craft. He was later transferred  
to Tucson, Ariz., and Grand  
Prairie, Texas, before return-  
ing to San Diego. He was a  
veteran of the U.S. Coast  
Guard, serving during World  
War II.

Surviving are his wife,  
Maxine; one son, Kenneth;  
two daughters, Patricia and  
Barbara; and several grandchil-  
dren.
